Asymmetry Hyperlaxity

Asymmetry:

Osseous dystrophy, upper prognathism, markedly ogival roof of the mouth, irregularly disposed teeth.

Tendency to scoliosis.

Tendency to osteoporosis.

Hyperlaxity:

Sprains, recurrent lumbago.
Voluminous varicose veins.

Visceral ptosis.

Aggravation:

- from humidity,
- from rest,
- when starting to move.

Improvement:

- with movement,
- with warmth and warm applications.
