Hepatic and digestive disorders Abdominal tympanites

Postprandial drowsiness and malaise. Intolerance to oysters, garlic, onions. Marked hunger leading to bad mood, but quickly satiated. Hunger at night.

Pyrosis, burning gastroesophageal reflux.

Distended abdomen, particularly in the lower part.

Varied disorders in patients with hepatic complaints.

Sore throat: right-sided, moving to the left.

Chronic obstruction of the nose.

Impotence, premature ejaculation.

Red sand in the urine.

Irritability.

In infants, digestive problems and anorexia.

In children, cyclic vomiting.

Aggravation:

- from fatty matters,
- from oysters,
- in the late afternoon (5 p.m.).

Improvement:

- with hot drinks,
- in the open air.
