

MERCURIUS SOLUBILIS

Prepared from mercuric nitrate, nitric acid, and metallic mercury

Mucopurulent secretions:

"discharges are always foul-smelling"

ENT disorders:

Acute or chronic tonsillitis.

Coryza with corrosive mucopurulent nasal discharge, with much sneezing.

Sinusitis with pains.

Mumps.

Mucopurulent loose cough.

Digestive disorders:

Fetid breath.

Tongue retaining lateral teeth-marks.

Intense thirst despite hypersalivation.

Greenish diarrhea, glairy or blood-streaked.

Dental problems:

Gingivitis, stomatitis, alveolodental pyorrhea.

Trembling of the extremities, aggravated by emotions and tiredness.

Sweating which does not relieve during febrile episodes.

Aggravation:

- at night,
- from damp cold.

Improvement:

- in a moderately warm and dry atmosphere

Mercurius vivus is prepared from metallic mercury. The pathogeneses of **Mercurius vivus** and **Mercurius solubilis** are identical.
